

How to Create an iMovie for the Web

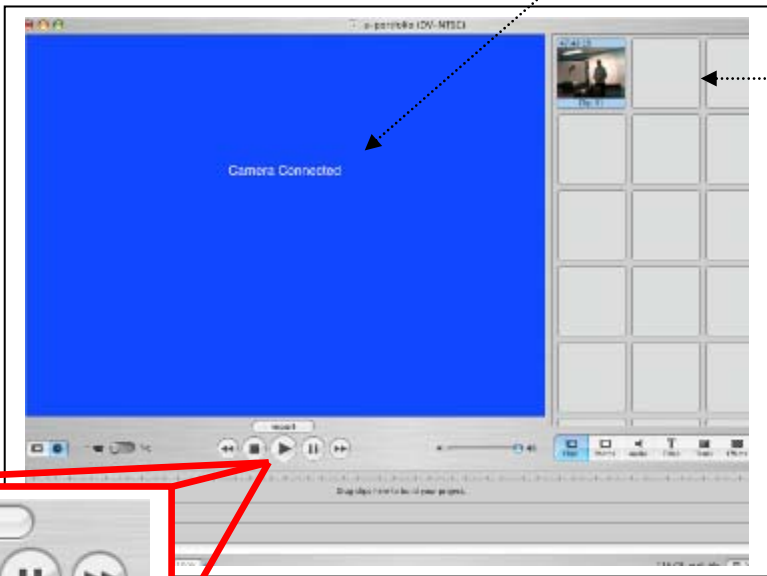


Open iMovie (Clipboard Icon) and select Create a New Project. Navigate to where you want to save your project and give it a meaningful name.

Once iMovie opens, if your video camera is connected correctly you should see the "Camera Connected" screen.

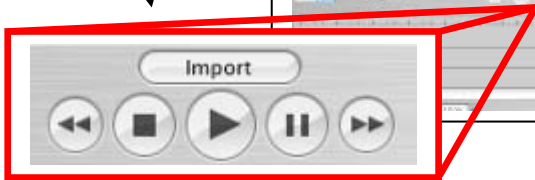
From this screen, the Playback controls allow you to watch, rewind, fastforward, or import your movie. *Similar to a VCR or DVD player.*

Click Import to begin importing your clip, click import again to stop.

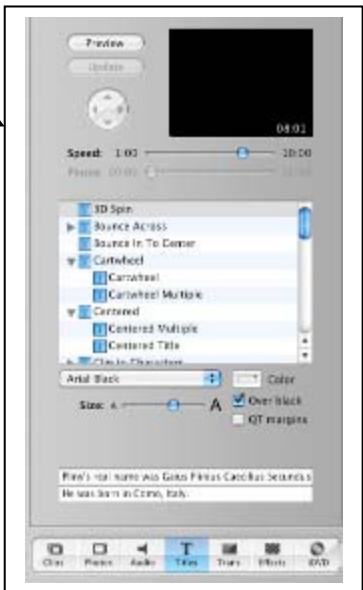


Once a clip has been imported, it will appear in the Clips section.

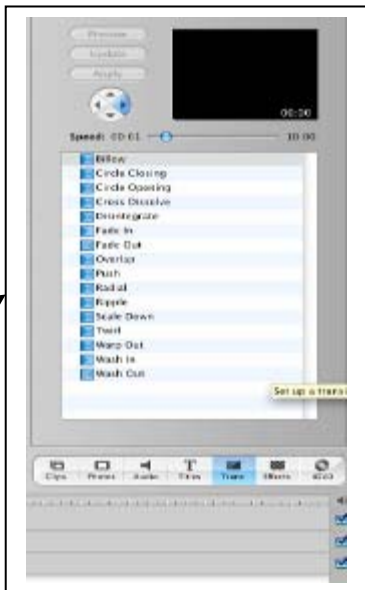
Drag your clip to the timeline to add them to your movie.



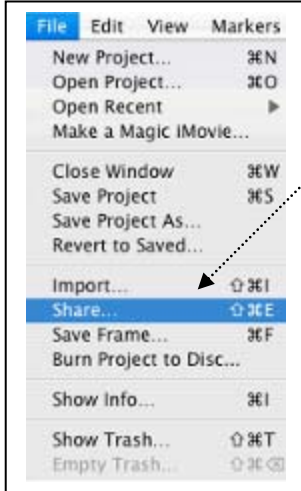
The *Titles* screen will allow you to create titles and drag them to your timeline



The *Transitions* screen allows you to create transitions between titles/clips and clips/clips.



How to Save an iMovie for the Web

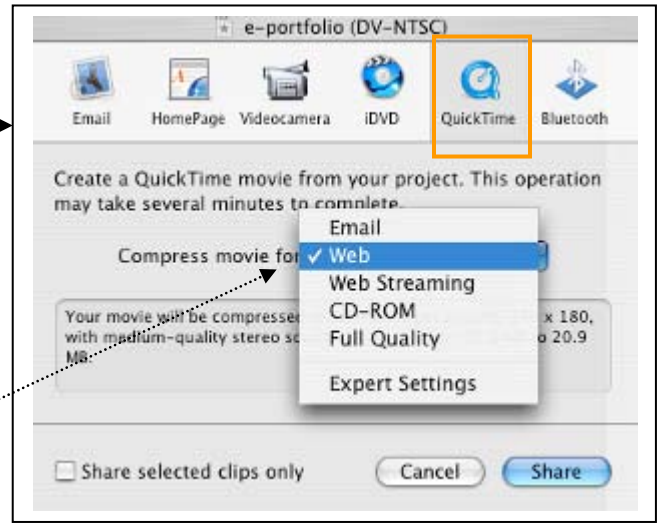


Select File → Share

This should open a new window allowing you to choose how you would like to share your movie.

Choose *QuickTime* .

From the drop-down menu, make sure *Web* is selected or has a checkmark next to it.



You will be asked to resave your movie. It will now have a .mov extension and be a more universal format.
